Problems or Repairs:

- 23. COSTUMES – Lucy’s lacy dress got some blood on it during tonight’s show, but the crew was able to spot treat it and the blood came out!
- 24. LIGHTING – Lantern 2 was having issues tonight. It turned on but was blue for the whole show, it didn’t change colors as programmed. It also had issues turning off when the others were cued to turn off. Stage Management tested several of the new batteries in the lantern at the end of the show and it was still blue and didn’t turn off when it was supposed to. Can this be looked at?
- 25. PROPS – One of the large crucifixes without a string seems to have gone missing sometime yesterday, 10/18. Stage Management and run crew checked in the pockets of all costumes and all around the backstage area and it didn’t turn up tonight. We are still able to get through the show with just one non-corded crucifix.

26. BLOOD/SPECIAL EFFECTS – One of the glitter glue bottles appears to be getting moldy on the inside. Stage Management set it aside with the moldy blood bag and used a clean one for tonight's performance.
