Problems or Repairs:

19. COSTUMES – The hat for Miller got a little bit of blood on it tonight when Miller's throat gets ripped out. It was not cleaned in any way as costume crew and Stage Management were unsure how to clean it. Is this something that can go through the wash or should it be cleaned a different way?
20. LIGHTING – The baby fogger on stage right made a loud whirring sound when it was used in Act 1 tonight. We noticed it was low on fogger fluid, so Lillie refilled both foggers during intermission. The stage left fogger worked well both times it was used but the stage right fogger made the same sound when it is used upstage of the fabric on lineset 20 for Dracula's reveal before Miller gets her throat ripped out. The second time it was used it barely puffed out fog. The SM Team tested the fogger again after the show and the issue remained. Can this be looked at?

<p>21. LIGHTING – Lantern 1 seemed to have a mind of its own tonight. There were several scenes when it would randomly change colors without a light cue ever being called or the “Go” button ever being hit on the light board. There was also a moment during Act 1 when it randomly turned on backstage on the props table without being triggered by a light cue. Lillie looked at them after the show and didn’t see anything out of the ordinary. Can this be looked at?</p> <p>22.
